

Whistler Chamber of Commerce – Prize Draws at LIVE events

1. Introduction

- This document outlines the terms and conditions for any and all prize draws ("Contest") organized by Whistler Chamber of Commerce ("Sponsor"). By entering the Contest, each entrant agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
- The Contest is open to residents of British Columbia, Canada, who are 19 years of age or older, excluding employees, directors, and officers of the Sponsor and its affiliates.

2. How to Enter

- To enter the Contest, entrants must attend the live event, and enter their name, and company details into the draw during the period specified at the live event, (typically following check-in at registration to the last call for draw prize entries) no purchase necessary.
- Entries are limited to one per person.
- Multiple entries will be disqualified.

3. Skill-Testing Question (If applicable)

- To ensure the Contest is not a lottery, entrants must also answer a skill question.
- The answer to the skill-testing question must be submitted along with the entry.

4. Prizes

- The Prize and approximate value to be awarded will be announced prior to the live event where possible
- The prize is offered "as is" and cannot be exchanged, transferred, or substituted.

5. Selection of Winners

- The winner will be selected by random draw from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period.
- The winner will be notified immediately and must be present at the live event to win.
- If the winner is not present at the time of the draw, or fails to respond to the notification, the prize may be forfeited, and a new winner may be selected.

6. Odds of Winning

- The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

7. Privacy

- By entering the Contest, entrants consent to the Sponsor's use of their personal information for the purposes of administering the Contest and, if applicable, for marketing purposes.

- Personal information will be handled in accordance with the Sponsor's privacy policy.

8. Limitation of Liability

- The Sponsor is not responsible for any technical difficulties, errors, or delays in entering the Contest.
- The Sponsor is not liable for any damages or losses arising from participation in the Contest or the use of the prize.

9. Governing Law

- These Terms and Conditions are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia, Canada.

10. General

- The Sponsor reserves the right to modify or cancel the Contest at any time, subject to applicable laws.
- The Sponsor's decisions are final and binding on all entrants.
- Any attempt to undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws.
